Experience: Steven Talbot is an Executive Director with CCS. In addition to his client responsibilities, Steven serves as a CCS Recruitment Officer, assists in business development and marketing, and has served as an Education Officer.

Steven is currently managing a \$110 million campaign for the Chao Family Comprehensive Cancer Center at University of California, Irvine (UCI). This is the first fundraising campaign of such a magnitude at the Cancer Center and the largest component of UCI's \$1 billion *Shaping the Future* campaign. The cancer campaign has raised over nearly \$40 million to date and is on pace to reach its goal by 2015. Steven developed and implemented the campaign's plan based on the feasibility and planning study he conducted in 2010.

Steven's first assignment with CCS was the \$28 million *Our Faith, Our Hope, Our Future* campaign for the Diocese of Tucson where he managed fifteen individual campaigns throughout southern Arizona. The campaign was a great success and raised \$44.3 million (158% of goal). Since then Steven has served a diverse portfolio of clients with services including audits, assessments, feasibility and planning studies, campaign plan development and implementation, major gift program development and request strategies, case writing, and fundraising training.
