On the other hand, the sheer number of decommissioning projects on the horizon opens up a huge amount of opportunity for the nuclear supply chain. Every level of the supply chain will see demand for their services and solutions upsurge in the coming years. The recent NDA announcement to continue the SME mentoring scheme annually only highlights the prospects for innovative companies breaking into nuclear.


