Re: Ms Juliet Ranger, D.O.B.: 15/03/1965

I am discharging Ms Juliet Ranger, a 58-year-old teacher, to your facility. She was admitted to Prospect Hospital for a fall, but her hospital course was complicated by hospital acquired pneumonia which will require pulmonary rehab.

Ms. Ranger presented to our hospital on 10/9/19 from a complicated fall involving a hairline fracture of the femur and significant blood loss. Her treatment included blood transfusion of two RCBs units for a hg of 5.8 mg/dl, morphine for pain management, and leg elevation with a pillow.

During admission on 16/9/19 Ms Ranger, developed hospital-acquired pneumonia which required IV antibiotics. After completion of the IV antibiotics course her condition improved, but she was still complaining of chest pain while coughing.

She has a significant family history of lung cancer from her mother and asthma from her father. She has had COPD since 2005.

Considering her history of COPD I recommended for her regular pulmonary rehab sessions. She will need to continue inhaler use for the COPD and has been prescribed an iron supplement due to the blood loss. She will receive a GP review in one week.
